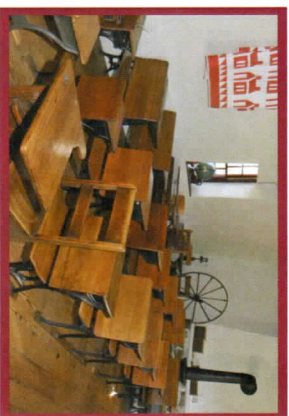
Located in the community of Lavall, off Rutland Road, about one-half mile from MD. Route 450
