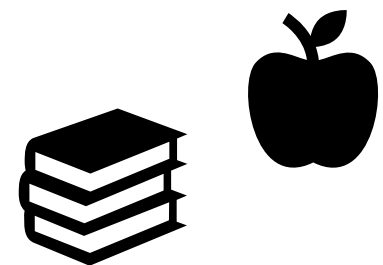
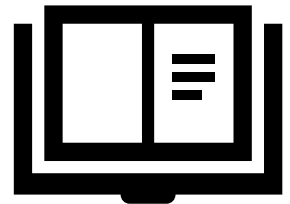
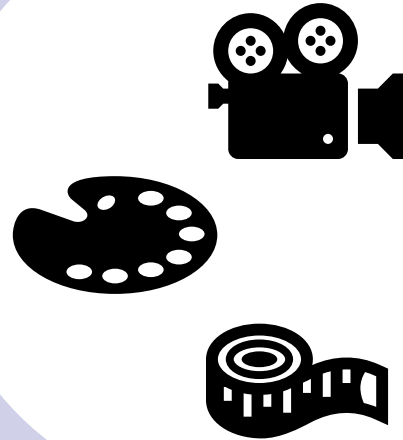
ANNAPOLIS 250 was established by the Annapolis City Council

- This has since been expanded to include all of Anne Arundel County

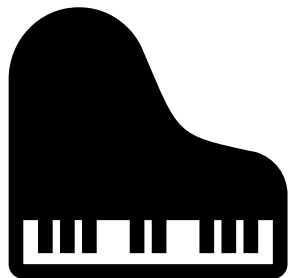

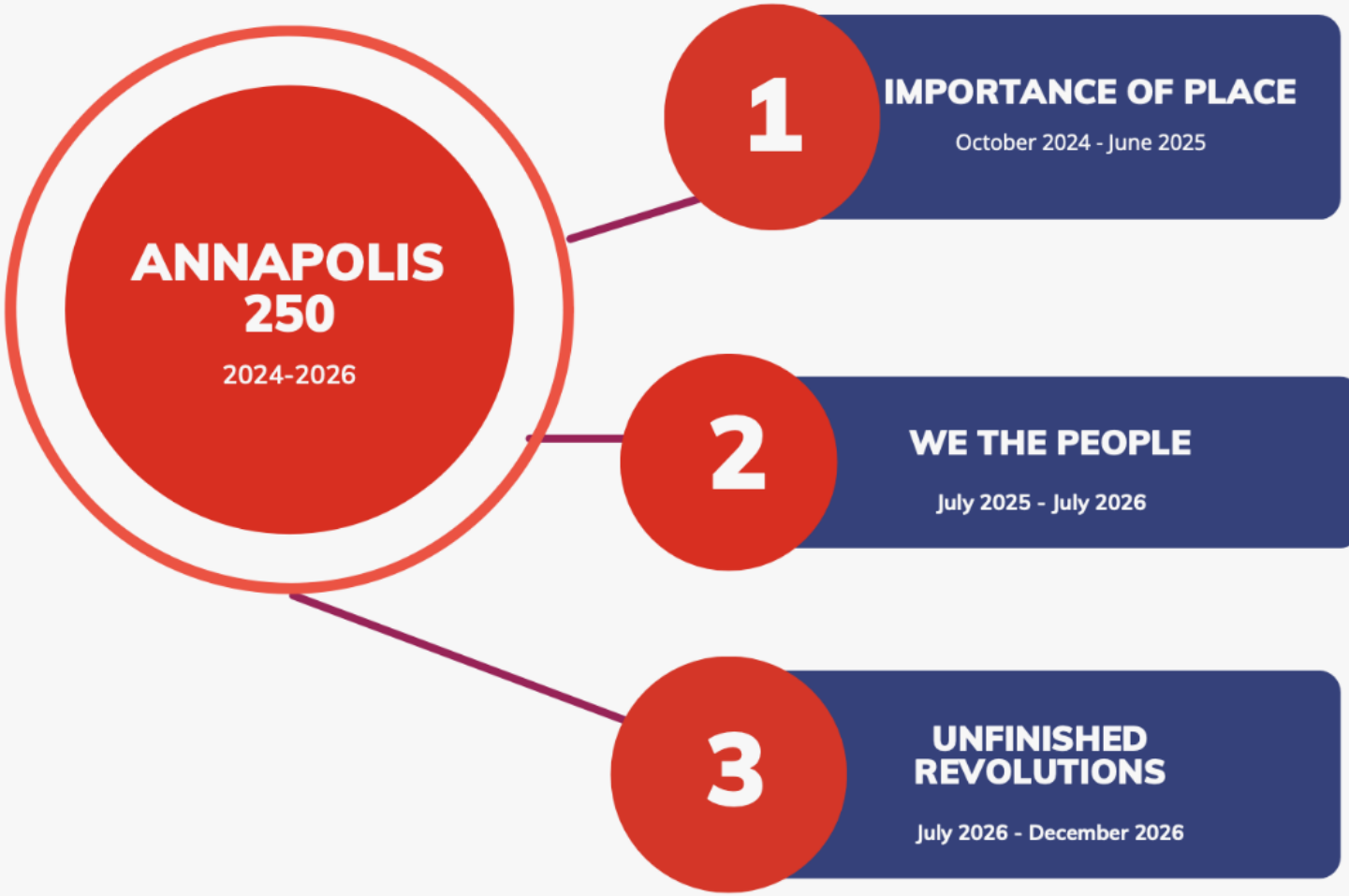
